4. Principal's Report - Jonathan Ferris

Jonathan reviewed the principal's report. There will be a draw for Late French Immersion if more than 30 kids are interested in Late French Immersion, which there usually are. Preference is given to siblings of children already in the French Immersion program. It is unknown at this time if the grade reconfiguration will affect the entry grade of Late French Immersion.
