Treasurer Report: Carnival raised \$3109.72. \$22,440.53 in General Account after expenses, \$3,539.59 in Gaming Account after expenses, \$4,699.40 in Technology Fund, \$4,699.40 in Playground Fund. 10% x 2 of final balance in General Account to be deposited into Technology and Playground funds as per the current Consitution and Bylaws, totalling \$2,244 for each account.

Streetwise Committee Report: Final Streetwise brochure to be expected in September. No recommendations have been made as collected data is still under review.

Carnival Committee Report: Tabled until June 25 General Meeting.

Munchalunch/Hot Lunch/Milk Report: Sally Weisbrod has resigned from her position for the 2018/2019 school year after 6 years working with the Hot Lunch program. Currently looking for a Munchalunch and Hot Lunch Coordinator. Anna Schappert will be working with Barbara Dekkers as the Milk Coordinator team for 2018/2019.

Principal's Report: Recap of past and upcoming events. Jonathan would like to thank attending PAC Executive members at the June 22 Assembly. Waterslides on June 28 needing parent volunteers. Strathcona is losing both portables at the end of June. Possibility of placing the Outdoor Classroom in the space freed by removal of the portables. Bell schedule next year will have 1 minute added of instructional time per day, shorting lunch by 1 minute. Letter grades will not be used for intermediate grades starting in September; will be using a sliding scale to gauge student progress. This will be implemented district wide.

Old and Ongoing Business: Fridge technician unable to find replacement for external reservoir on PAC fridge. He has made repairs to the cracked one and feels this should work long term. Jonathan is cautiously optimistic that PAC will be approved to make popcorn on school grounds, outside of the building. Waiting on written confirmation.
