Fall Weather Outdoor Attire

Parking Lot Reminders



With 330 students and over 35 staff members, Strathcona Elementary's parking is a busy area! With limited parking stalls and to reduce congestion, particularly at entrance area of the school, when possible, families are encouraged to walk to school. Drivers are also reminded not to park in parking stalls marked for staff.

There is a time limited Drop Off Zone along the front of school. DO NOT park and leave your vehicle in a drop off zone. All families, students, parents, and staff are reminded about the importance of using the crosswalk and sidewalks when walking to and from school, particularly using the crosswalk when walking across the parking lot. Thank you for your cooperation and making our parking lot as safe as possible.

When dropping your child off please have them exit the car on the curbside of the car to help keep everyone safe.

Wheels at School

A reminder that these "wheeled" modes of transportation (bicycles, scooters, skateboards, and other wheeled items) must be walked on and off school grounds for safety reasons. This includes the front of school sidewalk. With many younger students and pre-school children walking or running about an unfortunate accident could occur. Students riding wheeled "vehicles" are required to be wearing a helmet.

If possible, please try to schedule appointments or activities for your child outside of school hours to help protect instructional time & to adhere to safety protocols. If unavoidable, please notify the office and classroom teacher beforehand by calling or emailing the office, letting the classroom teacher know by email, sending a note or writing it in your child's planner.
